- (3) The maximum aggregate limit of liability for all **claims** first made during any Nonpracticing Extended Reporting Period will be equal to, in addition to, and not part of, the "Aggregate" limit of liability set forth in the Declarations, provided, that regardless of the number of Nonpracticing Extended Reporting Periods elected under this policy, the maximum aggregate limit of liability for all claims first made during all such Nonpracticing Extended Reporting Periods will not exceed the "Aggregate" limit of liability set forth in the Declarations.
- (4) If any other policy of insurance in effect would apply to any **claim** first made during the Nonpracticing Extended Reporting Period, then coverage provided under this policy during any Nonpracticing Extended Reporting Period will apply in excess of such other insurance.

All other terms, conditions and limitations of this policy will remain unchanged.
